3. The management and organization of the Championship

1.1 Championships are held, and the International Confederation of pyramid Federation of billiard sports of Russia under the auspices of the World Confederation of billiard sports on the basis of a single schedule of the RF Ministry of Sports. Organization and carrying out of the Championship conducted by the International Confederation of the pyramid, the Federation of billiard sports of Russia, the Ministry of Youth and Sports of the Republic of Tatarstan, the Federation of billiard sports of the Republic of Tatarstan. Direct the championship lies with the Federation of billiard sports of the Republic of Tatarstan (the Organizer) and the Ground Jury Championships approved by the International Confederation of the pyramid.

1.2 The Chairman of the Organizing Committee of the Championship - Insapov Farid Failovich.

1.3 The referee Kokunin Aleksandr Yurevich competition judge International category (Russia).

4. Participants and applications

1.4 The Championship participate the strongest athletes of the pyramid in the world.

1.5 To participate in the Championship the sportsmen included in the nominal application of the national federation of billiard sports. Quotas for national federations to athletes participating in the Championship are as follows:

1.5.1 3 men and 3 women - Russia, Belarus, Ukraine, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan,

1.5.2 6 men - Turkmenistan;

1.5.3 3 men and 2 women - Armenia, Azerbaijan, Moldova, Finland;

1.5.4 3 men and 2 women - Georgia, Lithuania;

1.5.5 2 men and 2 women Latvia, Mongolia, Estonia, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan.

1.5.6 12 men from foreign countries;

1.5.7 One male and one female - winners of the 2015 World Cup in the discipline of "Free Pyramid".

1.5.8 Men - World Cup winners of 2016 on "Free pyramid". (Moscow Mayor's Cup 2016), "Prince open" (2nd round).

1.5.9 Women - World Cup winners of 2016 on "Free pyramid". Including: Prince open "(1st, 2nd round), Moscow Mayor's Cup 2016 tournament Kremlin in 2016

1.5.10 Two men and two women - also from the host country of the World Cup. Official requests from member countries of the Championship will be sent to the November 20, 2016 by e-mail: e-mail: mail@fbsrf.ru.

Federation of billiard sports of Russia as the host country in the case lack of player has the right to claim further their athletes not to place the participants arrived. At the end of registration of participants will consider the possibility of allocating additional seats to national federations.

Meals (dinner) for athletes - at the expense of the Organizer.

5. Clothing.

For participants of the Championship is set dress code: dark shoes, costume dark pants, solid shirt, solid color vest, bow tie.

Participants are not in the prescribed form of clothes for the competition are not allowed.

Championships shall be governed by existing international law and the international rules of the competition in billiards.

6. Conditions and procedure for

Competitions are held according to the rules of the game in the IPC "Free pyramid" Provision taking into account the dispersion of the players command accessories.

Date for 3rd and 4th places are not conducted both athletes and two athletes, who played in the semi-finals, and did not pass to the finals will be awarded bronze medals and third place awarded to them.

All issues related to the changes and additions of conditions and procedures the Championship, and not included in this Regulation, to solve the main a panel of judges in agreement with the Organizer.

8. Refereeing

Judging Championship carried out in accordance with the Rules IPC.

9. Rewarding

Athletes who took second and third places will be awarded with: medals, diplomas and degrees cash prizes.
